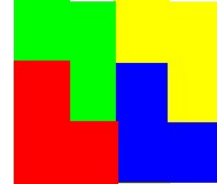

Now let's find out what our wonderful children have been up to...

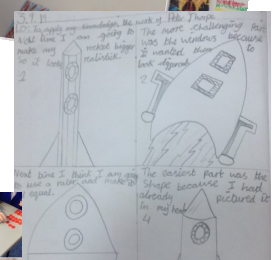
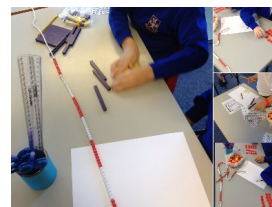
Class CJ have been enjoying practising their oil pastel and sketching skills in their new art books.
