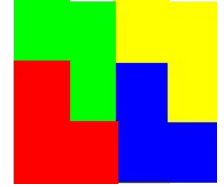

## Celebrating Your Learning

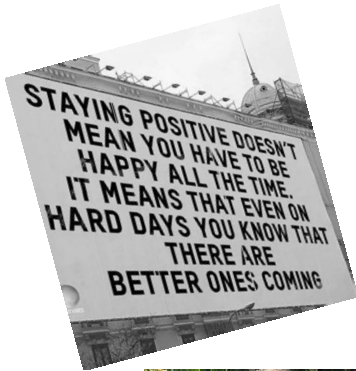
